## PHILANTHROPY

The Rotary Club of Dayton Foundation is the philanthropic arm of the Club, supported by voluntary member contributions and endowments. The Foundation awards general grants to registered nonprofit organizations on a rolling basis.

This year, we awarded eighteen grants totaling \$54,000, impacting pressing community issues and providing vital supports for our most vulnerable neighbors.

In 2024, the Rotary Club of Dayton launched Summerfest, a free end-of-summer community festival at Levitt Pavilion Dayton. With over 2,000 attendees in our first year, the festival promoted community, increased awareness of the Club, and raised over \$5,500 for the Foundation.

The highlight of the year came at Summerfest, when the Foundation awarded a \$50,000 Signature Grant to Daybreak, Inc. to provide mental health support and treatment to vulnerable and transient youth.
